### **2nd London Baptist Confession of Faith**

#### **Chapter 8: Of Christ, the Mediator**

Paragraph 3. The Lord Jesus, in His human nature thus united to the divine, in the person of the Son, was sanctified and anointed with the Holy Spirit above measure,<sup>13</sup> having in Him all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge;<sup>14</sup> in whom it pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell,<sup>15</sup> to the end that being holy, harmless, undefiled,<sup>16</sup> and full of grace and truth,<sup>17</sup> He might be thoroughly furnished to execute the office of mediator and surety;<sup>18</sup> which office He took not upon himself but was thereunto called by His Father;<sup>19</sup> who also put all power and judgement in His hand, and gave Him commandment to execute the same.

#### **Baptist Catechism**

Q. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?

A. The tenth commandment forbiddeth all discontentment with our own estate (1 Kings 21:4; Esther 5:13; 1 Cor. 10:10), envying or grieving at the good of our neighbour (Gal. 5:26; James 3:14, 16), and all inordinate motions and affections to anything that is his (Rom. 7:7, 8, 13:9; Deut. 5:21).
